1.1 What is AutoCAD LT software?

1.2 Who uses AutoCAD LT software?

AutoCAD LT software is used by drafters, architects, CAD technicians, designers, engineers, project managers, and CAD/IT managers in a variety of industries, including architecture, engineering, construction, manufacturing, civil, and mapping industries.

- Professionals who create precise, 2D technical drawings that document ideas and plans
- Drafters who put the finishing touches on a design with detailing, annotations, links to online data, and verification of accuracy
- Contractors, suppliers, and operational professionals who need to review a drawing to extrapolate data specific to their businesses

AutoCAD LT 2008 introduced automated annotation scaling and layer properties per viewport, making workarounds a thing of the past. AutoCAD LT 2009 provided improved drafting efficiency with a ribbon user interface that not only speeds up routine tasks, but also helps new users become productive as quickly as possible.

Now AutoCAD LT 2010 brings you additional 2D tools users have been asking for like ALIGN, xref, and block attribute commands. High-quality PDF output means you can easily share drawings with anyone. And you can save time by attaching PDFs as an underlay in drawing files.

Both AutoCAD[®] 2010 software and AutoCAD LT 2010 software programs use the same software architecture and technology, and both create files in the same native DWG file format and the DWF™ or PDF file specification. But AutoCAD 2010 provides additional capabilities in the following key areas:

- Advanced customization with LISP, ARX, and VBA
- 3D modeling capabilities using Free-form Design tools
- 3D visualization and rendering, and 3D printing
- Network licensing
- Management and automation capabilities with Sheet Set Manager and Action Recorder
- 3D printing
- CAD standards management tools

2. Availability and Pricing

2.1 When will AutoCAD LT 2010 software be available?

AutoCAD LT 2010 software will be available worldwide in English, German, and Japanese in March 2009.

2.2 When can I expect localized versions of AutoCAD LT 2010 software to ship?

Autodesk plans to ship localized versions for French, Spanish, Italian, Korean, Traditional Chinese, Simplified Chinese, Russian, Czech, Polish, and Hungarian. Autodesk also plans to provide documentation localized for Norway, Sweden, Netherlands, Denmark, and Finland. Autodesk will announce the expected ship dates as the localized versions become available.

2.3 What is the price for AutoCAD LT 2010 software?

Prices may vary by country and reseller. Locate a Reseller at www.autodesk.com/reseller for pricing information. In addition, upgrades are available from AutoCAD LT 2007, 2008, and 2009 versions.

2.5 Who is eligible for an upgrade to AutoCAD LT 2010 software?

If you own an AutoCAD LT 2007, 2008, or 2009 software license, you are eligible to purchase the upgrade version of AutoCAD LT 2010.

2.6 Can I try AutoCAD LT 2010 software before I buy it?

Yes, you can try it out by requesting a free 30-day AutoCAD LT 2010 software trial. This full-functioning version can be downloaded from www.autodesk.com/LT-Trial.

If I can't download the AutoCAD LT 2009 trial software, how else can I get it?

If you are having trouble completing the download, you can register at www.autodesk.com/autocadlttrialcd and have a trial CD sent to you.

2.7 Are there special purchase programs available for educational institutions or students?

3. Compatibility and Interoperability

3.1 Has the AutoCAD LT 2009 software DWG drawing file format changed for AutoCAD LT 2010?

Yes, AutoCAD LT 2010 uses a different DWG file format from AutoCAD LT 2009. However, AutoCAD LT 2010 has a built-in SaveAs function so you can save drawings to and from AutoCAD LT releases using the 2000, 2004, and 2007 DWG formats, among others. In addition, you can use the SaveAs AutoCAD Release 12 DXF™ command to support releases prior to AutoCAD LT 98.

3.2 Does AutoCAD LT 2010 software read and save drawings created by earlier releases of AutoCAD?

AutoCAD LT 2010 software reads drawing files from all previous versions of AutoCAD LT and AutoCAD software.

3.3 Is AutoCAD LT 2010 software interoperable with other Autodesk products?

Yes, AutoCAD LT 2010 software is built with the same technology as AutoCAD 2010. AutoCAD LT is also interoperable with the industry-specific AutoCAD-based products: AutoCAD® Architecture, AutoCAD® Map 3D, AutoCAD® Civil 3D®, AutoCAD® Electrical, and AutoCAD® Mechanical applications.

3.4 Can I run AutoCAD LT 2010 software side by side with other AutoCAD-based applications?

Yes, AutoCAD LT 2010 software can be installed side by side with AutoCAD as well as any version of Autodesk's industry-specific products, including AutoCAD Architecture, AutoCAD Map 3D, AutoCAD Civil 3D, AutoCAD Electrical, AutoCAD Mechanical, Autodesk Revit® Architecture, and Autodesk® Inventor® software applications.

3.5 Do AutoCAD LT 2006/2007/2008/2009 software customized menus work in AutoCAD LT 2010?

Yes, AutoCAD LT 2010 software automatically migrates customized menus (CUI files). The first time you launch AutoCAD LT 2010, the migration feature asks if you want to migrate your settings from your previous AutoCAD LT version to AutoCAD LT 2010. The migration feature helps you make a smooth transition to the new release by automatically migrating customized menus, hatch patterns, linetypes, command shortcuts, and profiles. 3.6 Does AutoCAD LT 2006 software or earlier customized menus work in AutoCAD LT 2010?

Yes, AutoCAD LT 2010 software loads customized menus (.mns, .mnu, and .mnr files). Once loaded they are converted to a .cui (customize user interface) file and can be used with AutoCAD LT 2010. By using the migration feature, AutoCAD LT 2010 sets your support files location for files such as menus and toolbar icons. Alternatively, you can use the CUI editor to move your customizations to the AutoCAD LT 2010 menu.

3.7 Do AutoCAD LT 2010 software CUI files work in previous versions of AutoCAD LT?

No, once a CUI file has been loaded into AutoCAD LT 2010, it can only be used in that version. Separate files must be maintained for earlier versions.

3.8 Can AutoCAD LT 2010 software work with custom objects created in Autodesk industry-specific software?

Yes, the AutoCAD LT 2010 software application can view custom objects created in Autodesk products that use RealDWG™ technology to create those objects. With the AutoCAD LT 2010 application you can display object data from industry-specific software using object enablers—some of which are shipped with the application. 5. Licensing

5.1 Does AutoCAD LT 2010 software use product activation for stand-alone licenses?

Yes, with the release of AutoCAD LT 2005 software the process formerly referred to as “authorization” was replaced by the more industry-standard “product activation.” AutoCAD LT 2010 continues to use product activation.

5.2 What is product activation?

Product activation is a software-based license management technology incorporated into many Autodesk products. It is a secure and trouble-free process that authenticates licensed users running Autodesk software. The process verifies that the serial number is legitimate and has not been activated on more computers than are eligible. It does not affect the ability of licensed users to operate their software the way they have always done. It is similar to the authorization mechanism in Autodesk products in the past but provides additional capabilities for security and special product versions (such as student and trial versions).

5.3 Why does Autodesk require Autodesk customers to activate their software?

Product activation is a simple way to reduce and deter unauthorized use and casual copying of Autodesk products, with little to no impact on loyal customers.

5.4 How do I activate my software?

Through the activation and registration interface, you can activate your product 24 hours a day, seven days a week, over the Internet or via email. Either option takes only a few steps to complete and requires your product serial number and registration information.

5.5 What if I have more than one computer? Will product activation allow me to use the software on multiple machines?

Autodesk recognizes that some users may need to operate the software when they are away from their usual work location. To accommodate this need, the product activation technology and the AutoCAD LT software End-User License Agreement allow an employee to install the software on a second computer owned by the employee’s company, provided it is for use away from the employee’s usual work location, the two copies are used only by

that employee and no other, and only one copy of the software is ever in use at any one time.
